

Accession to the Protocols by the Republic of Suriname

On 16 December 1985 the Republic of Suriname deposited with the Swiss Government an instrument of accession to the Protocols additional to the Geneva Conventions of 12 August 1949 and relating to the protection of victims of international armed conflicts (Protocol I) and non-international armed conflicts (Protocol II), adopted in Geneva on 8 June 1977.

In accordance with their provisions, the Protocols will come into force for the Republic of Suriname on 16 June 1986.

This accession brings to 55 the number of States party to Protocol I and to 48 those party to Protocol II.
