

IN THE RED CROSS WORLD

STANDING COMMISSION OF THE INTERNATIONAL RED CROSS

The Standing Commission met in ordinary session on 29 April in Geneva.

Under the chairmanship of Angela, Countess of Limerick (United Kingdom), it was attended by the two International Committee representatives, Mr. Marcel A. Naville, President, and Mr. Jean Pictet, Vice-President, the two representatives of the League of Red Cross Societies, Mr. José Barroso, Chairman of the League Board of Governors, and Mr. Eustasio Villanueva Vadillo (Spain), and the members elected by the International Conference of the Red Cross, namely General James F. Collins (USA), Dr. Djebli-Elaydouni (Morocco), Sir Geoffrey Newman-Morris (Australia), Dr. F. G. Zaharov, Vice-President of the Alliance of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies of the USSR, in place of Professor G. Miterev, and Mr. T. W. Sloper, Adviser to the Commission.

The Commission's main concern was the organization of the XXII International Conference of the Red Cross.
