CD-ROM, bilingual English and French, on international humanitarian law ("IHL")

You will quickly be able to:

- find a text or a specific article of a treaty;
- check which States have signed, ratified or acceded or succeeded to a convention;
- scan the texts and match a given provision with the corresponding commentary, etc.

What does the IHL CD-ROM comprise?

- some 87 treaties and other texts: Law of The Hague, Law of Geneva and other IHL treaties dating from 1856 to the present;
- the commentaries published by the ICRC on the four Geneva Conventions of 1949 and their 1977 Additional Protocols;
- an up-to-date list of signatures, ratifications, accessions and successions relating to IHL treaties, as well as the full text of reservations, declarations and objections thereto (as at 31 December 1994).

To use the CD-ROM IHL, you need:

- **IBM PC, XT, AT, PS/2 or compatible, with 640 K RAM and hard;**
- **Black and white monitor or colour monitor with VGA graphic card;**
- **MS-DOS 3.1, or higher;**
- **Standard CD-ROM drive (ISO 9660)**
